


Moodle: Embed a Video Recording

Step 1


Log into Moodle at nwrpca.net/moodle. Find your course. On your course home-page select **Turn Editing On**.

Step 2

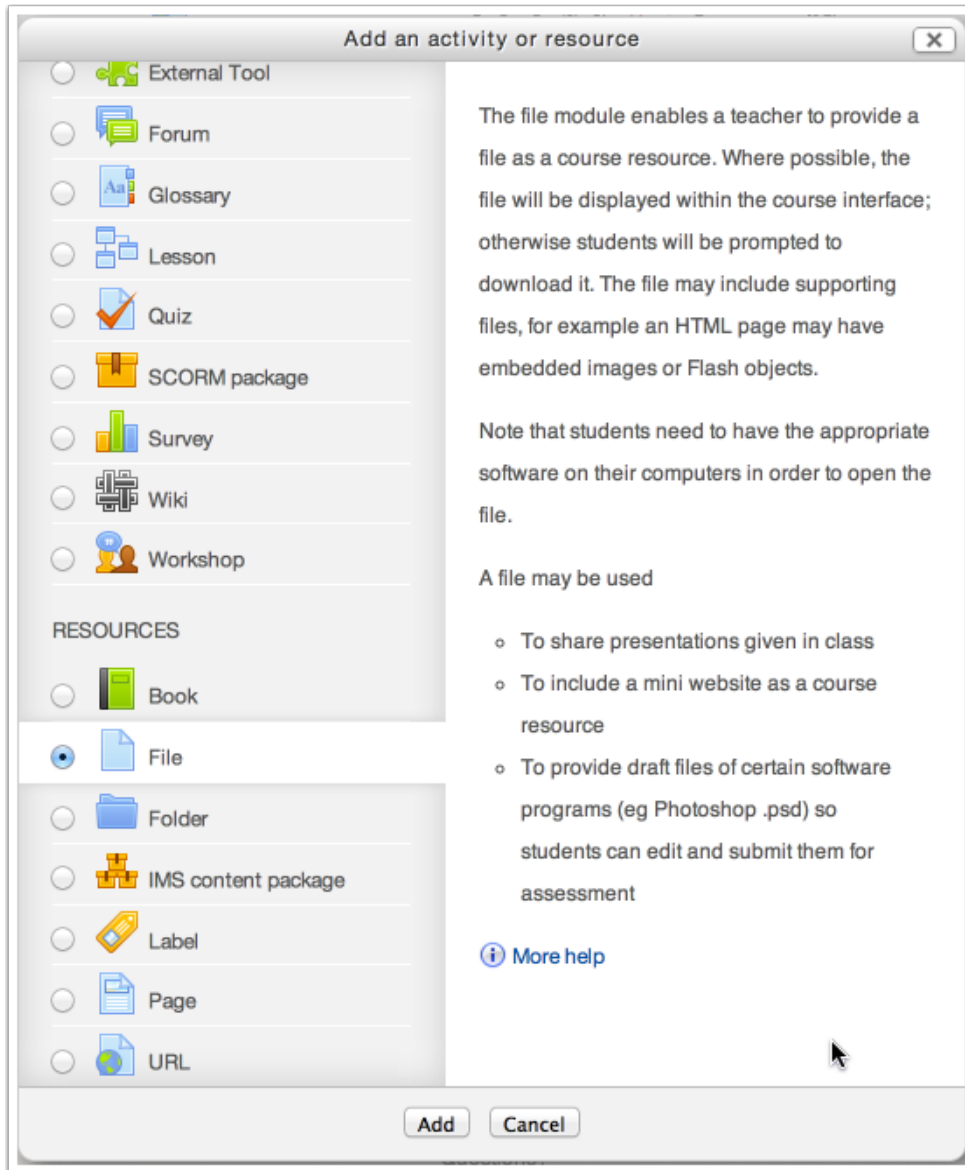
Select **Add an activity or resource** from the section to which you want to add a forum.
